

Europe

1. In July 2016, the Taiwan EPA (Office of Greenhouse Gases Reduction and Management) and the European Economic and Trade Office (EETO) jointly organized the International Conference on Climate Change - Capacity Building in Regional Carbon Markets in Taipei. Experts, including from the European Commission and the German Federal Environment Agency, were invited to share their experiences and exchange information on emission trading schemes and carbon market capacity building.
2. In September 2015, the Taiwan EPA (Office of Greenhouse Gases Reduction and Management) held the "Towards a zero carbon future: Call for action to address the risks of climate change" Nobel class master forum. Professor Hans Joachim Schellnhuber, Director of the Potsdam Institute for Climate Impact Research (PIK) in Germany was invited and gave a keynote speech entitled "Humanity at the Crossroads".
3. In June 2015, the Taiwan EPA (Office of Greenhouse Gases Reduction and Management) held the International Conference on Low Carbon Technologies for Carbon Reduction. Experts, including from the German Federal Environment Agency, were invited to discuss global carbon reduction strategy.
4. In December 2014, the Taiwan EPA (Department of Comprehensive Planning) and the Trade Council of Denmark, Taipei, jointly organized the Taiwan-Denmark Multidisciplinary Design Forum to share Danish experiences on environmental education.
